A LEARNING EXPERIENCE AT COIMBATORE, TAMIL NADU



The three-days programme on the art and skill of writing funding proposals was put on by the Karl Hubel Institute for Development Education. It took place at Coimbatore, a city of Tamil Nadu and was led by Trainer Dr. Arumugam Gurusamy. The opportunity to attend this 3-days training programme from July 11–13, 2023 was wonderful one. In this mixed-race group, three of us—Srs. Sumitra Xalxo, DSA, Pirmita Kerketta, DSA and Seema Ekka, DSA—were from Jharkhand.

The majority of the members however, were from Andhra Pradesh and Kerala. There were 22 contestants in all. Teamsters were introduced to each one in a different way after the three-days programme.

Followed by our introductions, there was an ice-breaking activity that left us dumbfounded and speechless. The first lesson began by emphasizing the moral: “Learning comes from sharing and sharing comes from learning.” The instructor was highly educated and active, so he spent a lot of time explaining and discussing with the participants the positive aspects of sharing through which we learn in order to generate fresh ideas and improve our abilities to learn and communicate.

Later, he began with how we can understand an individual or donor, how we comprehend a company and how we interpret the institution or rule. Each person teaches and shares in a unique way, thus it is important to analyse

how you personally grasp the material, how you relate to the subject and how you influence others to understand. As we begin to comprehend, we must concentrate and begin to think synodically.

I gained a lot of knowledge including writing techniques for grant proposals, what to mention and what to omit and why. I learnt about the project's major elements which are crucial for raising money. It discusses how to plan, how to draw a plan (resource mobilization), opportunities, idea justification, economic viability, credibility and time constraints which are also known as results. The most important aspect of sustainability that I could learn about is how systemic notions evolve in relation to the persistence of economic, social, philosophical and environmental concepts in human civilization. The sustainability debate came up next. The journeys suggest that it should be governed by law and have a short-term perspective, proactive plans and responsive systems. These lead to the transformation of a new market and new strategy.

The second day's lesson focused on creating a good fundraising request and it taught me to be detailed rather than generic. I was also shown how to use SMART in all of my funding proposals as it outlines the following five criteria:

- S- Specific
- M-Measurable
- A-Achievable
- R- Realisable
- T-Time bound

The third day of my class covered a crucial topic called "Essential Components of a Funding Proposal". It helped me to visualize our fundraising request to our benefactor, the crucial elements such as the proposal which is a summary and the project/organizational introduction, the requirement I look for as well as writing the goal and result. Thus, the three-days workshop in Coimbatore was a good success. Being able to learn something new from other NGOs, institutes and

organizations was a major accomplishment for me. I also had the opportunity to visit Mumbai and speak with NGOs staff over there. This experience opened my eyes to new sights and inspired me profoundly.

I express my gratitude to Rev. Sr. Lily Grace Topno, DSA, our Superior General for her kind permission to go to Coimbatore. I appreciate the encouragement and best wishes from each and every member of General Council. I am grateful to the Project Commission Office and Srs. Ruth Xalxo, DSA and Martha Xalxo, DSA who connected me with this course and assisted me. I am thankful to the Superior and Sisters of Generalate Community for their fervent prayers, love, care and concern, all of which have helped me mature and carry out my responsibilities with sincerity. THE EXPERIENCE OF TWO YEARS IN ROME

I am Sr. Alice Topno, DSA I study in the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross, Rome. I am attending a 5-year course, a 3-year bachelor's degree and a 2-year master's degree in institutional social communication. I started the course in 2021 and successfully completed the two years. The university offers many courses and gives the opportunity to grow in all aspects including intellectual, practical and spiritual aspect. It focuses on the personal growth of each student, paving the way to address current issues and problems in society to which the Church must respond. The university prepares future Church communicators by making them responsible persons and leaders in the field of communication. The School of Church Communication aims to train professionals to work and reflect on communication for Church institutions and other non-profit organisations. Inspired by the Christian faith, they must be able to analyse and interpret social trends, exploit technical and strategic innovations and make prudent professional

decisions for the good of society as a whole. This course offers the opportunity to train students for the diocese and religious institutions. Therefore, students are trained with correct information and introduction of current situations. The students are given the opportunity to acquire knowledge and make quick decisions at the right time and place. There are students from different countries who attend the course to be a good communicator for the universal Church.

I started my academic year in October 2021 with enthusiasm, expectations, dreams and hopes. I was happy to enter the university. Besides enthusiasm, there were also anxiety and fear, expectations of my Congregation and the excitement of learning new things. The first year served me to observe and adopt all the new things, such as teaching, writing, speaking method etc. In particular, it was important to get to know the teachers and their teaching style. I started to adopt slowly, but it took time.

There was a language problem, even though I had been here in Italy for many years, but normal conversation is different from the language of the book. I understood, but I could not assimilate. This forced me to face the current situation. The group discussion with my classmates and the helpfulness of the teachers supported me a lot to understand the materials well. By doing, I learnt. I took some appropriate subjects in Philosophy that have to do with communication. Attending all the courses this year was useful to me for the mission of the Congregation, especially in the field of evangelization.

The second year was easy for me to understand the material. I made an effort to get it right and it went well. There were many interesting things to learn and get to know. In the second year, I also took some theological subjects that are useful and combined with communication. I felt that theological preparation is essential and it provided richness to institutional communication.



While attending the course, the needs of our Congregation are becoming very clear. I could see the real need of our Congregation especially in the area of communication. I am grateful to my authorities for giving me an opportunity and preparing me for further mission. Prompt response and self-updating with information are the basis of communication. I personally feel the great need for social communication in religious institutions for mission in present era.

ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE OF TWO YEARS' STUDIES

I am happy to share personal experience of my two years study in the faculty of Centro San Pietro Favre per I Formatori al Sacerdozio e alla Vita Consacrata, in Pontifical Gregorian University Rome. I successfully completed the licentiate in vocational training study from October 2021 – June 2023. These two years of study gave me various opportunities to learn and develop myself both in psychological and spiritual aspects. Indeed, it was a great occasion to study over there with 2,845 students coming from 5 continents and 125 countries as university carries 14 faculties to educate the young Priests and Nuns from various Congregations and youths as well. The students coming from different personalities, cultures, places and traditions tried to adjust and mingle with one another.

My attention goes to faculty Centro San Pietro Favre where I am enriched more with various studies and activities organized by the faculty. Here, I would like to share some of my insights, thoughts, ideas and inspirations of my studies of these two years. The subjects arranged over there, mainly dealt with personal growths of a person in spiritual and psychological aspects and formative accompaniments of formators to the candidates with regards to human, spiritual, intellectual, pastoral and communitarian maturity of growths. It helps us to bring emotional maturity and capacity to accept

oneself with strengths and weaknesses, ability to integrate oneself in the present society with various challenges. Therefore, four dimensional aspects of human education were focused more in order to grow in human maturity. Because it helps a person in presenting the necessary and dynamic foundation of all priestly or religious life. It helps in shaping the quality of the vocational ministry and provides the rational tools needed to understand all the values that belong to being a pastor and making them incarnate in the daily life of the candidates that helps them to transmit the content of faith appropriately in one's current life and in the future life as a consecrated person. It helps the candidates to become responsible and renders himself/herself being fruitful in ecclesial service. So, to achieve this kind of integral growth, a person needs to develop self-knowledge or self-awareness and self-acceptance.

Apart from the classes, there were also extra activities such as - visit to different Congregations, group activity, prayers, academic outing, gathering etc. There were arranged also some awareness programs to know the present situation of family, society and world, both negative and positive aspects, from where the young boys and girls are entering the Congregation to become the Priests and Nuns, the challenges that formators are facing in the process of accompaniment to the candidates in the formation. How Church understands and cooperates the priestly and religious formation. This course gives more emphasis on personal growth or maturity.

I feel really privileged to have this course and so, it is my duty to express my sentiments of gratitude to all my authorities, especially the Superior General Rev.
